Application Requirements

1. Applicants must be male graduating senior or junior from an accredited high school in Kent/Sussex County, Delaware.
2. The student must have a grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
3. The student must complete all of the forms in the scholarship application package
4. The student will be evaluated on the following:
 - a. Academic Achievement
 - b. Extra-Curricular Activities
 - c. Leadership
 - d. Community Involvement
 - e. Education Potential
5. During their College Freshman year, the student must register in a college or university with minimum of 12 credits in the academic year. (Note: a certified copy of the students Letter of Enrollment is required).
6. Official transcripts must be provided in a sealed envelope.
7. The student must be available to attend the following Alpha Phi Alpha programs:
 - a. Leadership Development Institute (usually 3rd week of June or alternate session in 3rd week of July in Washington DC/MD/VA or New York City area)
 - b. March of Dimes/Project Alpha (usually in November)
 - c. Receive award at the annual MLK Breakfast (MLK Day, 3rd Monday of January)
